Dundee City Council, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Section 208 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, being satisfied that it is necessary to authorise the stopping up of the footway hereinafter specified in the Order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of that Act hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as "Dundee City Council (Douglas Street, Dundee) (Stopping-Up)
 Order 2011 and shall come into operation on the date when confirmation of the order is
 advertised.
- 2. In this Order, "roads and footpaths" means the length of public streets in the City of Dundee, which are specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. The stopping-up of the footway at Douglas Street, Dundee is hereby authorised.
- 4. Where, immediately before the date of this Order, there are any rights of statutory undertakers in respect of any apparatus which is under, in, on, over, along or across the lengths of footway such undertakers shall thereafter, without prejudice to the provisions of Section 224 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997, have the same rights in respect of that apparatus as they had immediately before that date.


Area of Footway to be Stopped-Up

Those areas of footway known as Douglas Street, Dundee depicted on the attached plan no T-11-04-1 will be stopped up as follows:

DOUGLAS STREET

- 1. From the intersection of the extended south building line of the former Parkhill Business Centre with the boundary wall situated on the west edge of the westmost access to Parkhill Business Centre at a point marked "A" eastwards for a distance of 19.7 metres or thereby following the extended south building line of Parkhill Business Centre to a point marked "B".
- 2. From the point marked "B" southwestwards for a distance of 20 metres or thereby to a point which is 1.9 metres or thereby northwards from the intersection of the north kerbline of Douglas Street with the extended line of the boundary wall on the west edge of the westmost access to Parkhill Business Centre to a point marked "C".
- 3. From point "C" northwards for a distance of 3.4 metres or thereby following the line of the boundary wall on the west edge of the westmost access to Parkhill Business Centre back to point "A".
